

# Vendor Rules 2017

## Nebraska Reptile Breeders Expo

- Only healthy **captive born** animals for sale at the Nebraska Reptile Breeders expo.
- All animals must be legal to sell in the city limits of Omaha, Nebraska
- **NO** venomous, **NO** Crocodylian, **NO** Iguanas, **NO** live: mammals, rodents or birds □ Snakes over eight feet in length at maturity display only. [List provided.](#)
- Lizards over five feet in length at maturity display only. [List provided.](#)
- **Only** official exhibitors are permitted to sell at the Nebraska Reptile Breeders Expo. No outside animals allowed... Animals taken out of the display area cannot be returned.
- Nothing is to be displayed or sold in the hotel or in the Hotel's many parking lots.
- **All** animals must be kept in secure containers and may be displayed at your table or directly in front of table. Questions please ask...
- Expo management must approve all displays of prohibited animals. These animals will not be for sale Education only
- All rules subject to change without notice.
- If you choose to take reptiles to your hotel please do so discreetly. Use boxes that are not clear. Many hotels have rules against animals in rooms. If you are discreet and put a "Do not disturb" sign on you door, you will NOT have a problem with hotel management or staff.

# Nebraska Reptile Breeders Expo

OMAHA city code is that the following types of animals are not permitted for sale: Lizards that exceed 5 feet in length as adults (it does not matter what the actual individual size of the animal is, if the average length of adults exceeds 5 feet) Snakes that exceed 8 feet as adults (again, hatchlings of these animals are not permitted).

Specifically, the following animals are not permitted in Omaha (Please note: this list may not be exhaustive, and you should consider the above types of animals for evaluating the legality of any animal not included in this list):

Not for Sale in Omaha, Nebraska (this hotel, and hotel parking lot)
