- Enders Reservoir SRA and WMA are located in Chase County, Nebraska near the southwest corner of the State.
- Habitat is mainly mixed-grass prairie with abundant limestone ledges lining the small canyons.
- Camping is available at Enders SRA.
- Motel lodging is available in Imperial (10 miles northwest) and Benkelman (27 miles south).
- Rattlesnakes are abundant! Care should be taken when walking around in the grasslands.
